CEAO's Board of Directors has established a scholarship program for Civil Engineering and/or Surveying students attending school in the State of Ohio. The intent of the Board is to increase awareness of the County Engineering profession and to encourage students and current county employees to become registered both as a Professional Engineer and as a Professional Surveyor.

Scholarships will be awarded to Civil Engineering and Surveying students at the Junior and Senior level of a Bachelors program and to current county employees who are taking the required additional surveying courses to work toward their dual registration. Applications should be submitted directly to the CEAO office; selections will be made by the CEAO Scholarship Committee. **The checks for those applicants who are awarded a scholarship will be written to the school and not the individual. The scholarship money is not intended to be used as a reimbursement.**

Completed applications are due **by March 31, 2023**. Applications and copies of official transcripts must be mailed to the CEAO office (6500 Busch Blvd., Suite 100, Columbus, OH 43229). The application form is included with this letter.
